

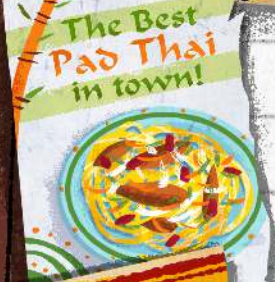
# Food "A-Cross" the World
